

Glenn County Rangeland Association (GCRA) 2020 Scholarship Qualifications, Instructions and Application

Qualifications: To qualify for this \$200 scholarship from the Glenn County Rangeland Association, recipients must meet the following:

1. Be a senior in High School and be graduating in June 2020.
2. Live in the Rangeland Association membership area, which is Glenn County west of County Road D and the Stonyford area.
3. Show proof of residence if requested.
4. Planning to pursue agricultural related studies after High School during the fall/winter of 2020. This includes trade school, college, university, vocational program or similar educational endeavor.
5. The scholarship is open to all students who meet the above qualifications and submit a valid application.

Instructions and Requirements:

1. Complete the following application form. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
 2. Attach to the application form an essay explaining to the Rangeland Association what you will do with the scholarship funds to further your post-High School agricultural education.
 3. Attach to the application a signed recommendation from a teacher or counselor on official letterhead, or from an adult not related in any way to the applicant.
 4. Attach proof of enrollment in a post-High School trade school, college, university, vocational program or similar educational endeavor.

 - 2020 scholarship funds must be claimed by December 31, 2020. If not claimed by December 31, 2020, the applicant-winner will forfeit all rights and claims to the funds.
 - The scholarship winner will be invited to make a presentation at the fall GCRA membership meeting in November 2020, about what they plan to do with the scholarship funds.
 - The scholarship winner will be announced by June 1, 2020.
