Hugh Hammond Bennett Led the soil conservation movement in the United States 1920s and 1930s








President Franklin Delano Roosevelt wrote a letter to the governors of all the states recommending legislation that would allow local landowners to form Soil Conservation Districts.







- 3 stock water ponds
- 45 acres brush clearing
- 45 acres range seeding
- 175 acres range fertilization
- 160 acres cropping systems
- A feasibility survey, plans and specifications for one state-size irrigation and stock watering reservoir
- Assisted Mendocino National Forest with establishment of several dams
- Cash on hand December 31, 1960 totaled \$58.51






