

PROCEDURES FOR LETTER OF SUPPORT INQUIRY REQUESTS

- **Step 1** Request submitted to TG-FSC: RCD of TC (District Manager) or Glenn County RCD (Executive Officer); request must include both A. and B. below.
 - A. Letter of Support Inquiry Request Form (PDF or Word version) **We found the fillable PDF was a little challenging in completing / font size too small to read
 - B. Sample Letter of Support (Word version)
- **Step 2** TG-FSC Ad Hoc Committee "Tehama County" representatives review and provide input on Tehama projects, "Glenn County" representatives review and provide input on Glenn projects
- **Step 3** TG-FSC Ad Hoc Committee "Tehama County" representatives email final draft letters on TG-FSC letterhead with their recommendations included in email, vice versa
- Step 4 TG-FSC Ad Hoc Committee ALL review recommendation and make a decision YES or NO
- **Step 5** Once agreed upon, if YES, TG-FSC Ad Hoc Committee member "Fire Coordinator" from other county would execute and email back to all
- **Step 6** If NO, TG-FSC Ad Hoc Committee provides recommendations for project improvement
