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Glenn County RCD and CAFF Announce Colusa Subbasin SGMA 201 Event to be Held in Early September 2 & 3

GLENN AND COLUSA COUNTIES, Calif. — Glenn County Resource Conservation District (RCD), in partnership with Community Alliance with Family Farmers (CAFF), is pleased to announce the upcoming Colusa Subbasin SGMA 201 event, a free educational workshop designed to help local growers, landowners, and community members better understand the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA) and what local groundwater management means for them.

SGMA 201 will build on the basics of the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act and provide attendees with information about how the Colusa Groundwater Authority and Glenn Groundwater Authority are working to achieve groundwater sustainability within the Colusa Subbasin.

The workshop will cover several important topics currently affecting groundwater users, including:

- An overview of SGMA and local implementation
- Groundwater Demand Management (GDM), including the draft GDM Program and how it may affect groundwater users
- An overview of the Water Accounting System
- What a water accounting statement is and how to understand the information and data it provides
- Ways growers, landowners, and community members can become involved and support local groundwater management decisions

The goal of SGMA 201 is to provide practical, understandable information so groundwater users can stay informed and be proactive in protecting local water resources. Attendees will also have an opportunity to ask questions and learn more about the decisions being considered within the Colusa Subbasin.
